Foaming Effervescence (bubbles)

- ★1 cup Muggle dishwashing detergent (Joy, Dawn or Ajax are best)
- ★1 gallon water
- ★1 tablespoon glycerin (optional-makes stronger bubbles)

Mix all ingredients and let bubbles settle. Use a bubble wand or chenille stem shaped like a quidditch hoop to blow your bubbles.



Aqueous Elixir (goo)

- ★ 1 cup cornstarch
- ★ 1/2 cup water
- ★ Food coloring

Mix all ingredients.

This is great for squeezing through your hands. You can change the consistency by adding more water, then more cornstarch.

Tantalizing Tattoos



- ★ 1 tablespoon cold cream
- ★ 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- ★ 1 tablespoon water
- ★ Food coloring
- ★ Paint brush (clean)

Mix all ingredients together, stirring to mix well. Using the paintbrush, create your tattoo.

Taper Concoction (play dough)

- ★ 1 cup flour
- ★ 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- ★ 1 cup water
- ★ 1/2 cup salt
- ★ 2 teaspoons cream of tartar
- ★ Food coloring

Mix all ingredients in saucepan. Heat, stirring constantly until ball forms. Knead until smooth.

Fantasy Froth *(bath foam)*

- ★ Muggle Shaving cream
- ★ Liquid food coloring in various shades
- ★ Muffin tin or other small plastic containers

Tint shaving cream with a couple drops of liquid food coloring. Place colored shaving cream into a muffin tin or other small plastic containers. Use the food coloring sparingly to avoid staining skin. To prevent accidental shrinking or Dragon Pox, test a bit of the cream by applying a dab to the inside of your arm.



Mesmerising Magma *(volcano lava)*

- ★ 1 teaspoon baking soda
- ★ Red food coloring
- ★ 1/2 cup vinegar

Place baking soda inside a cup. In a separate container mix food coloring and vinegar. When you want your magma to erupt, pour the vinegar into the cup and stand back!

Knut Clarifier (penny cleaner)

- ★ 1 paper cup
- ★ vinegar
- ★ salt
- ★ knut or penny



Fill paper cup halfway with vinegar. Add about 2 tablespoons salt. Drop in the one knut (or penny) and watch what happens!
