Week 25 Pattern – July 6, 2011

Note: For pattern pieces – WHITE indicates background fabric. All other colors are approximate representations (colors are intentionally light to save ink), but you are welcome to use any fabric colors you see fit. If necessary, reference photos of each week's block are available on hp_paperpiecing.

All Blocks are 10” finished (10 ½” unfinished¹).

When printing, make sure “scaling” is set to “none.”

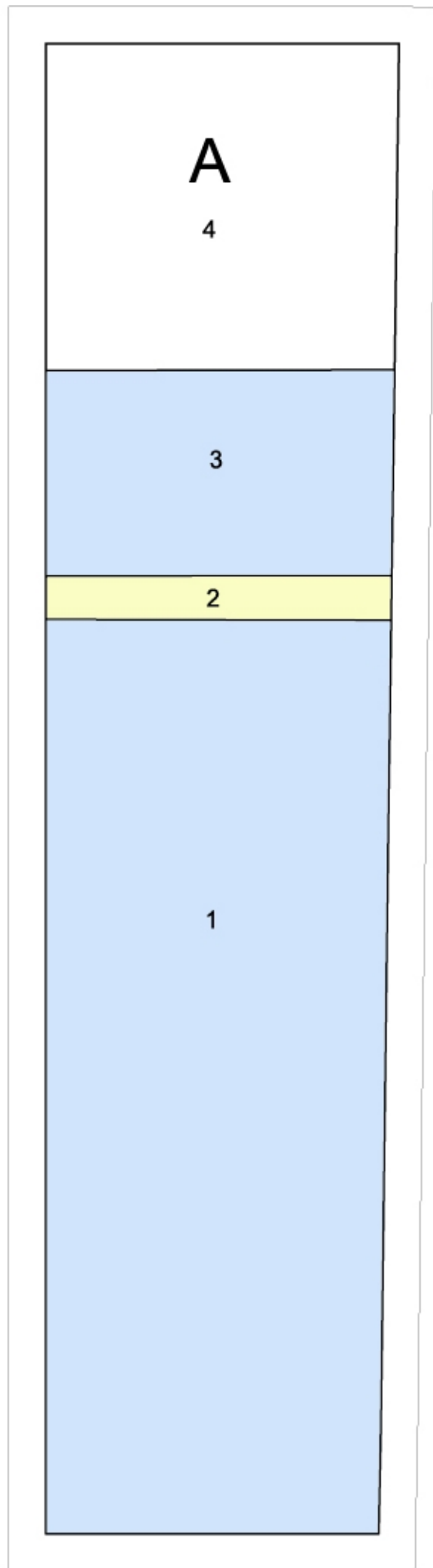
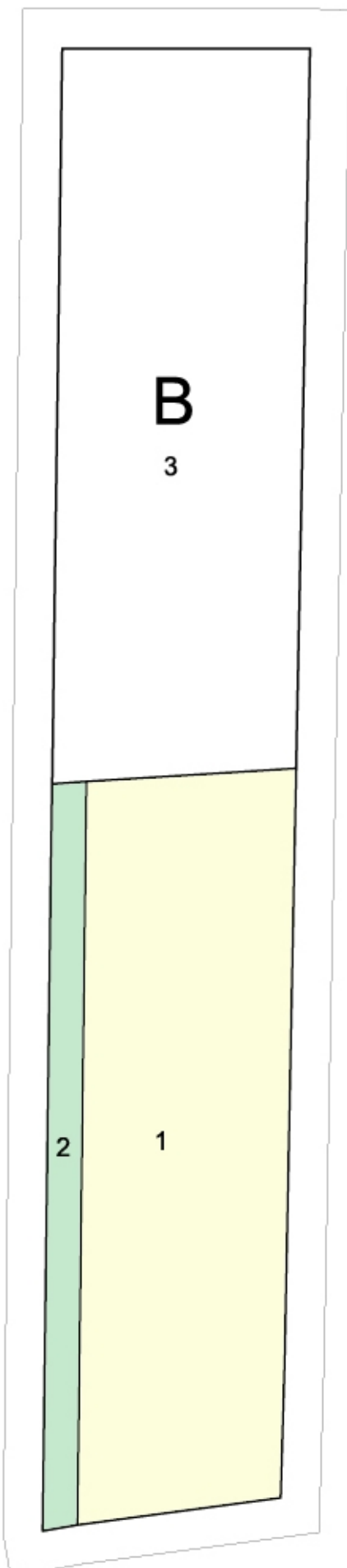
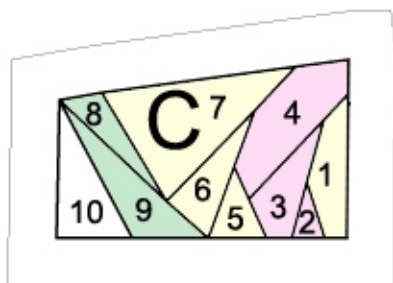
Sewing Order

(patterns are assembled left to right and top to bottom)

B>C

A>BC>D

¹*Square up block using a large ruler. Try to leave fabric extended past the edges of the OUTSIDE seam allowance as you sew in case your pattern prints slightly smaller. If necessary, extra fabric can be added to the top and sides of the blocks, but not to the bottom, which will interfere with the final quilt design.*
